The majority of our funding comes from private donations of items and monetary donations. We also receive funding from United Way and a few grants. We use our monetary donations to purchase products such as diapers and baby wipes, items needed for the grocery distribution and for the milk coupons. First United Methodist Church not only provides the space for our program, but is a major supporter of our program. Harvest Table could not function without the support of the entire community.
